ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

What is the digital mentoring programme PhD Success Lab?

PhD Success Lab is an online course that PhD candidates follow over a period of 12 weeks. You receive weekly instructions and material that you study and follow to progress with your PhD. The programme includes educational video lessons, and detailed worksheets, and is enhanced by virtual live sessions, a discussion group, and close interaction with the programme instructor.

Why join PhD Success Lab?

As a PhD candidate, you face many challenges: deliver first-class research that will qualify you to get the PhD degree, organise your own project, manage time and resources, facilitate cooperation with collaborators, cope with unexpected processes in your research, publish papers, write a thesis, and many more.

Universities and institutes only provide a framework in which PhD candidates operate. Supervisors observe and guide the research process, but their resources are limited. Additional support, skills, techniques, and specific strategies are often required to enable you to conduct and complete a PhD study successfully. Our digital mentoring programme PhD Success Lab provides exactly this essential support.

Why not just join a short course or ask the supervisor?

In short courses, participants have to block a few days in their calendar and get all content provided in a very condensed format. Questions and problems can be addressed on a theoretical but not on a practical level on the individual's project. Implementing the learned content has to be done by participants after the course is finished.



In PhD Success Lab, you are supported over a couple of weeks to make sure that learning, implementation and feedback go hand in hand. Like in a real lab, any problem that comes up in the implementation process can be addressed and the necessary instructions are provided to improve. In contrast to supervision, the PhD Success Lab allows the necessary time and the tools to acquire the skills and strategies needed to complete the PhD successfully and on time.

What you learn in this programme?

- ▶ How to plan and control the PhD project
- ▶ How to become a well-organised, highly efficient and focussed PhD candidate
- ▶ How to organise the writing of each part of the thesis and how to write in the most productive way
- ▶ How to communicate professionally with supervisors and collaborators
- ▶ How to complete the project successfully

How do you work in this programme?

You receive regular but small tasks that follow a proven roadmap to achieve your goals step by step. You access the learning material from our e-learning platform and work on the materials in your own time. This allows you to follow the programme even in a busy academic schedule or when located remotely.

Who benefits most?

PhD Success Lab is a perfect fit if you're enrolled in a PhD programme or have started on a PhD project already. It is helpful for you if you're in the first year and want to avoid common problems. It is also highly suitable for you if you're well into the PhD process and have experienced problems, or if you're delayed with your project. Also for PhD candidates who are in the last year, the programme will provide useful strategies to bring the project to the finish line.

What topics do we cover?

PhD Success Lab deals with the four big challenges you face in your PhD study:

Part 01: is about how to set up a system to plan and control your PhD project.

Part 02: is about developing yourself and organising your time.

Part 03: is about mastering dissertation writing.

Part 04: is about optimising communication with supervisors and collaborators.



How is the programme taught?

PhD Success Lab is a fully digital programme that is provided online through an interactive e-learning platform. You work independently using the provided material.

The programme includes 10 learning modules with 29 lessons and two implementation weeks. A new module with new lessons is released weekly, which is accessible everywhere.

Each lesson includes an educational video in which the next step in the PhD process is explained. It provides guidelines about the respective step and ends with a task that needs to be completed. Besides, each lesson includes PDF documents, written guidelines, and checklists to support you in mastering each step. You always implement directly to your own situation and PhD projects.

The programme is complemented with four live video sessions with the instructor to clarify questions on the material, and help directly with problems in the individual PhD progress. The sessions take place about every 2–3 weeks. Throughout the entire programme, our instructor is available for your questions.

You'll receive extensive course material including checklists. When the programme comes to an end, you can still use all materials as long as you need them. All material is provided digitally, you cannot miss anything and have lifelong access to the material.

We award an ECTS certificate with 3 ECTS credit points (approx. 75 h).

Date and fees

PhD Success Lab is offered 2–3 times per year to make sure you can participate when it best suits you. The next programme round starts on **February 23rd, 2026**.

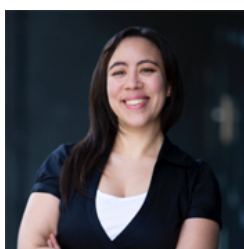
